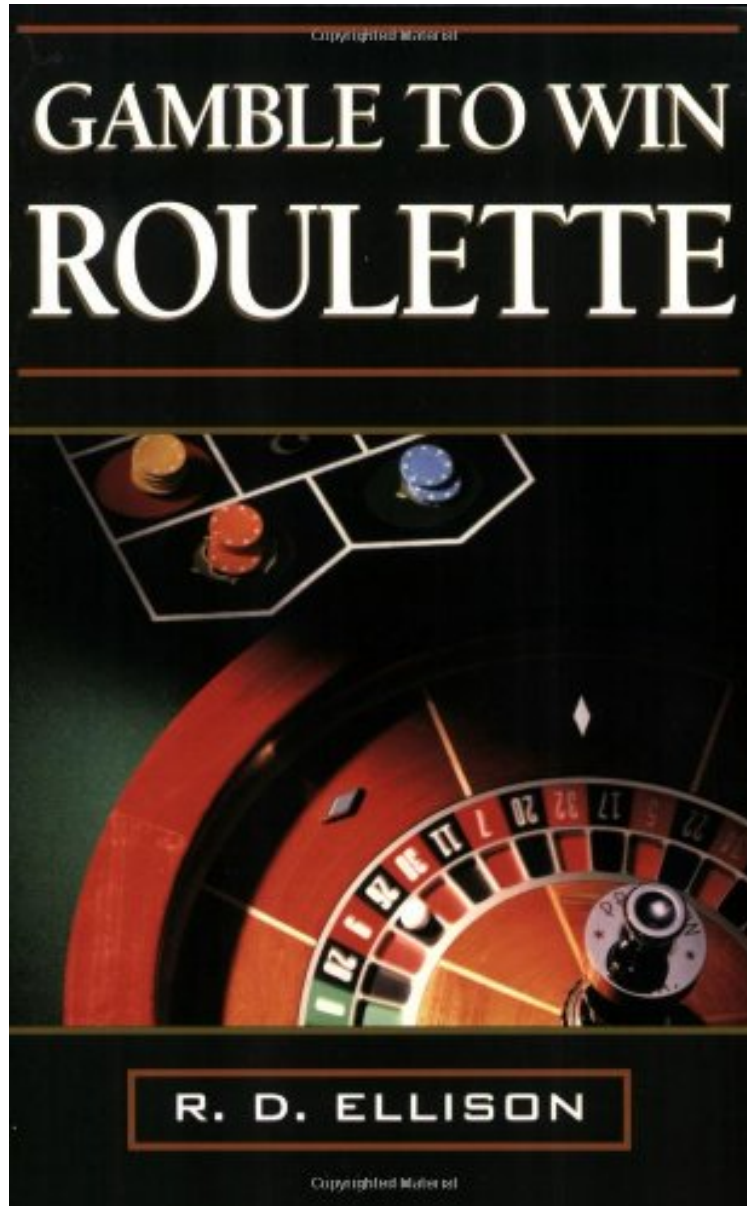

parlayed into oblivion. It is however about an attitude and approach to gambling as a business or investment expected to (hopefully) pay handsome returns on 4, 3, split and straight up bets; or at least dividends on the other inside bets and the outside. Oh and if You don't understand what I'm talking about, the book is an excellent primer and will make the prior gibberish sensible. As for the writing style I'd say its easy to approach and digest as Ellison comes off as a freindly learned person who genuinely wishes to impart the art of moving wisely. The book explains the rules and layout and ettiquette of the game. But just about every roulette book does this. (GTW) goes much further and teaches how to think statistics (including the Law of Large Numbers and the need for surgical strikes against the wheel and casino), systems, cash/emotional management, TRENDS analysys and procedural considerations to know when tides are changing and how to guide decisions accordingly. The book is worth having on your shelf even if you don't play roulette as it teaches common sense. And too it is cheap even at \$1000 as it will save the savvy reader tens of thousands of dollars in stupid bets over the years. Ultimately its about the INDIVIDUALS Respsibility to recognize they are walking into an areana where the odds are against them but beatable. The book does offer a primary two-part system (3Q/A) which I tested randomly on my home wheel along w/ five other systems I'd developed. They came out even and ahead! In the casino I tried this and got slaughtered for \$160 (I test systems w/ ones and fives so as not to be to hurt by losses). Still I blended his systems w/ My own ideas and have improved My results. As I said the book is worth owning but not if YOU are lazy.
