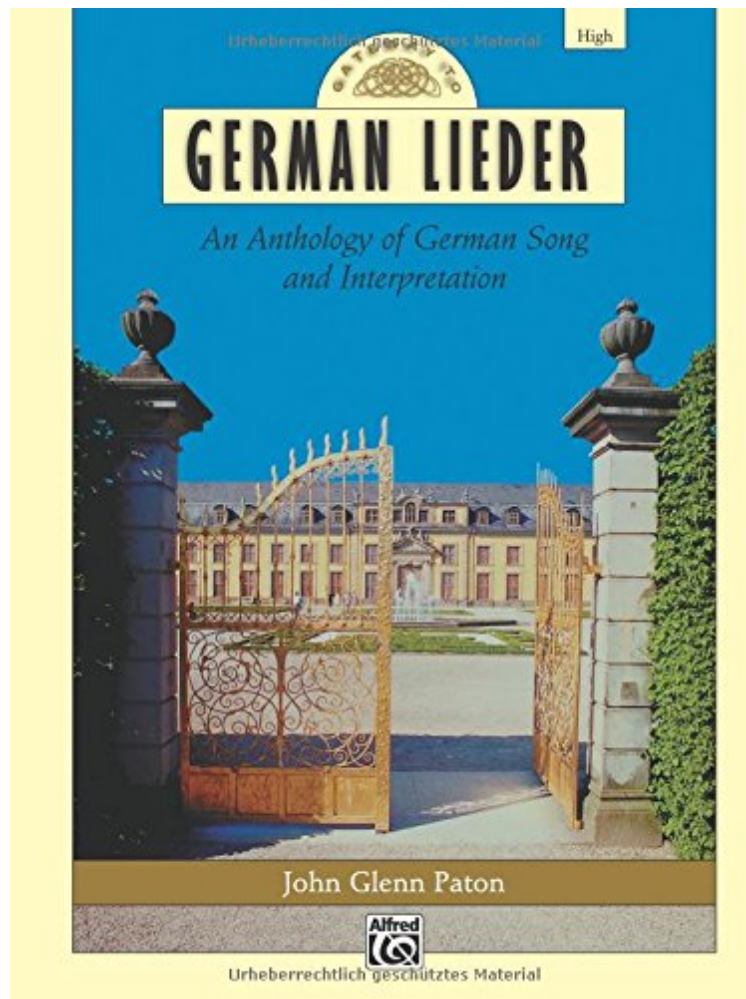

some less known but beautiful pieces. The translations are very good and are word for word. They are not meant to be sung but are accurate representations of the texts, making it easy to develop accurate interpretation of the music. "Gateway to German Lieder" also includes phonetic pronunciation for the German also. Overall, the book is very useful for singers who do not speak German but want to perform in the original language. The accompaniments on the CDs make a useful addition to the scores themselves. They are very well played on piano (not midi files). Singers may find it helpful to have accurate accompaniments available when learning pieces since the melody is often not heard in the accompaniment. Therefore singing the piece while hearing the accompaniment may take some practice. The accompaniments may differ from the tempi singers chose for performance, but they are played at the speed suggested by the composers. This book with CDs has remained one of my long-time favorites.

Great masters of lieder from Beethoven to Richard Strauss are represented among 48 songs that have been chosen for their appeal to young singers. Musical excerpts studied in Gateway to German Diction appear as complete scores. The comb binding creates a lay-flat book that is perfect for study and performance.
