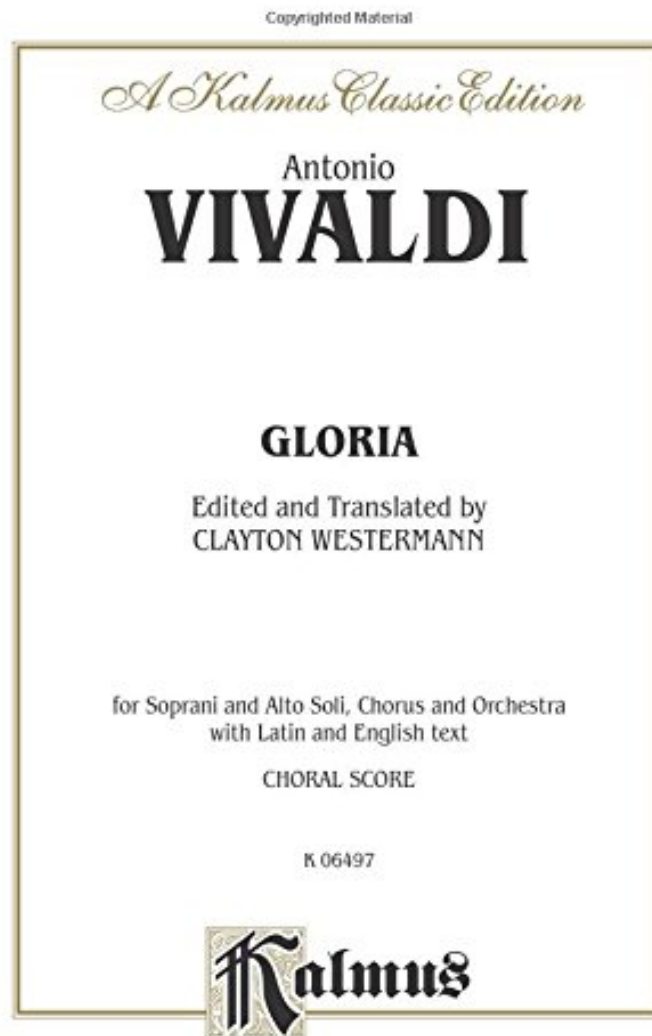

Also one page has the alto section printed as singing in the bass clef blatant error. This is the Alfred publishing company edition that printed it. There is another publishing company for Kalmus and that in is light but at least the note values are clear.

This is the choral score of the most famous of the several Vivaldi works with the title of "Gloria." This edition and translation by Clayton Westermann features vocal text both in Latin and English, and a piano reduction of the orchestral parts (including figured bass). There is also a short preface by the editor to explain performance practice. The score has 76 pages and is very legible.
