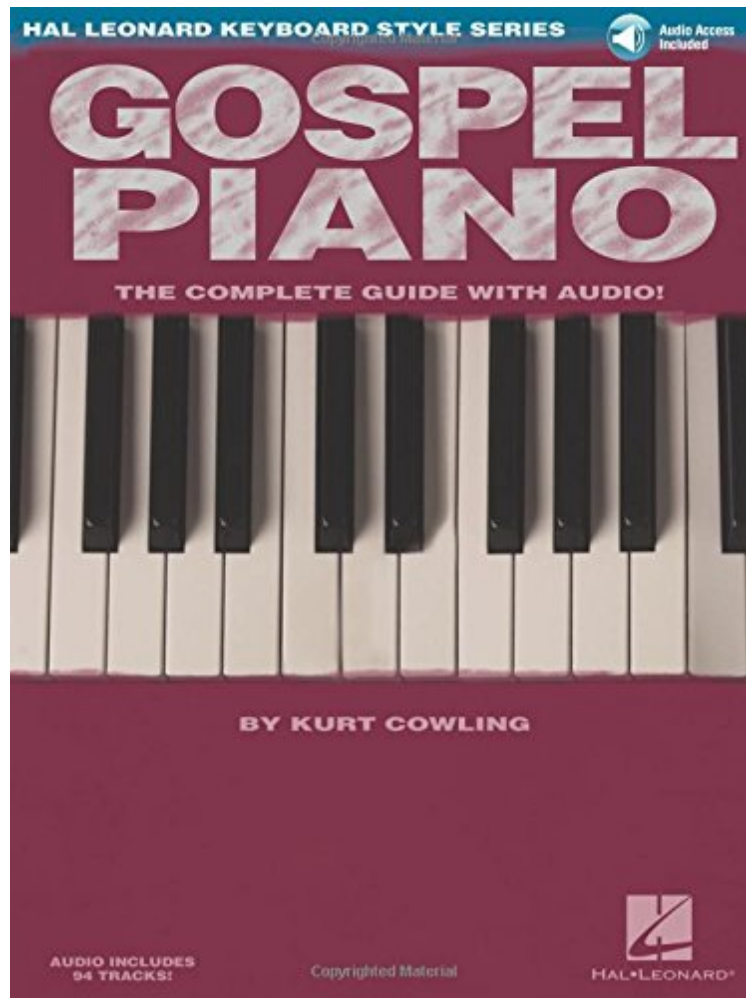

The recorded examples are the best I've ever heard on a Keyboard Styles CD. The author states in the intro that the book is intended for the advanced player with good sight reading skills. I play by ear. So it is great to have these exciting musical phrases transcribed. The examples have lots of chord changes per measure played against highly syncopated left hand bass lines, mostly three notes in the right hand with the bass note completing the full chord voicing. I agree with the one reviewer who said the examples

were not Ray Charles sounding. The sound is more pop oriented. And there is a boat load of theory crammed into this book, like when to use diminished chords, chord couplings and such. I play mostly blues, so the changes presented in this book are brand new for me. I don't expect to be able to play the examples note for note, but the book presents a whole new palette of musical ideas that will enhance my personal style. I'm really excited about getting into it. I may even go to church!
