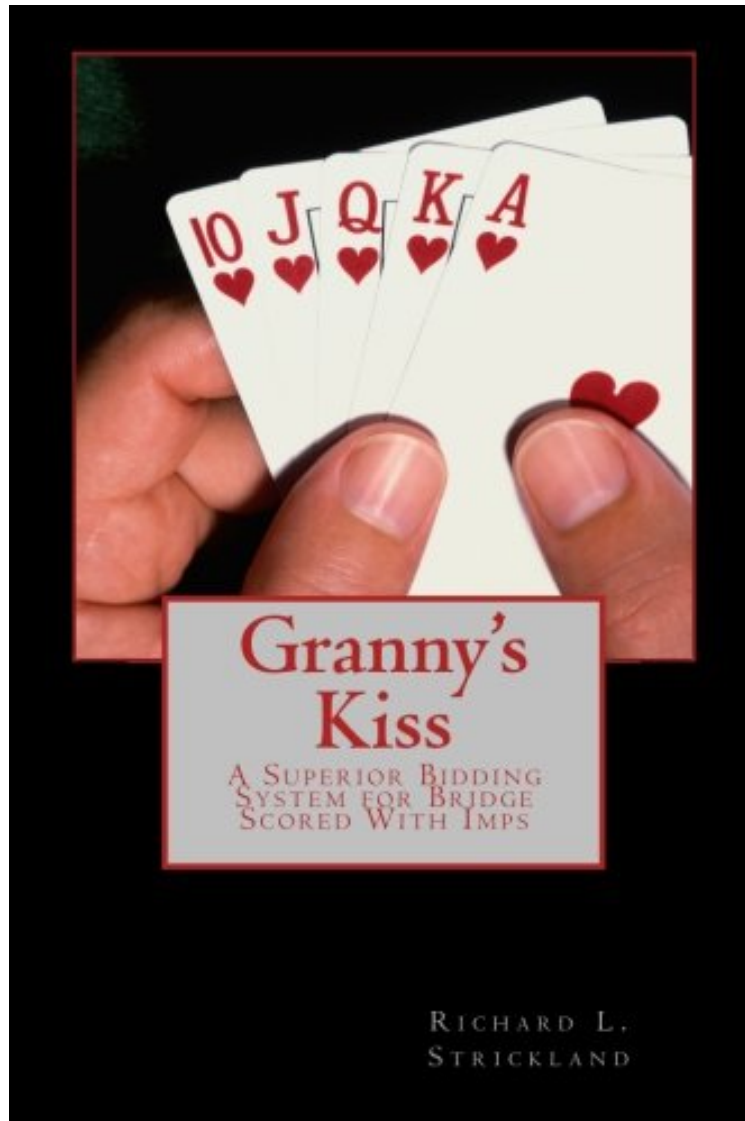

0 of 0 people found the following review helpful. Wholly InadequateBy CJMI had to stop reading this. The topic of the book (canape bidding) interests me greatly and I very much enjoyed Ken Rexford's book on the topic, and the idea

of doing this in the context of one-diamond rather than one-club being the strong opening is also interesting. I was prepared to overlook as oddities that the author does all hand-evaluations in defensive tricks rather than high-card points, and that some hands are diagrammed spades-first, while others are diagrammed clubs first. But even worse, the bidding system isn't adequately explained. For example, it's not clear which of responder's rebids are forcing. (I read all the material on uncontested auctions that start with one-club -- one-diamond, which would be a very common start in this system, and this was never discussed...not even a general rule for understanding which ones are forcing.) The analysis is also incorrect...for example showing an auction that ends in 3NT with the comment that it will make, when it's clear fairly straightforward defense will set it. For canape systems, read Rexford's book instead. (Rexford is also conscious of what is and is not allowed in North American tournament, and tells the reader, whereas this book introduces transfer preempts without even warning the reader...as far as I could tell from skimming the relevant sections...that these will not be allowed in most events they might play in.) For strong diamond systems specifically, you'd be better off googling for system notes someone might have posted on the web.0 of 0 people found the following review helpful. Some very good options to be considered even if one does not play the full system
