I have tried to access it on my Laptop throughout the Kindle app for Windows 8, and my phone, a Note 3 running Android 5, and my tablet, a Dell Venue 8 with Android 4.4. Firstly there is not index or table of contents, of course the print edition doesn't have these either as it is essentially just a "coffee table" book meant more for show than actual reference purposes. Secondly it is impossible to read on anything other than a computer or very large screened tablet so again on a phone it's useless. Finally it is very difficult to turn the pages even to use it in by browsing. To make both the print and digital editions more user friendly I would suggest the addition of at least an index to enable it to be used for looking up items of interest.0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
